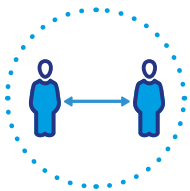

## COVID GUIDELINES

These guidelines are for our exhibitors, contractors and all persons involved in our events. Incorporating best practices to ensure we safely and responsibly resume the running of our events while prioritising the health and safety of all persons involved.

### FOR VISITORS, EXHIBITORS & CONTRACTORS



Keep a distance of 2m from each other



Temperature measurement at all the entrance points of ADNEC



Sneeze/cough in the armpit



Avoid handshaking



Wear a mask covering nose and mouth



Wash/sanitize hands regularly



Respect the maximum capacity of conference rooms



Follow floor indications: one-way and two-way aisles indicated by floor marks

# COVID GUIDELINES

## EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES



Maximum number of people inside a booth: 1 person per 4 sqm



The signage board indicating the capacity should be at least 50cm by 30cm and be placed right in front of the booth.



Brochures and flyers are recommended to be provided digitally or via QR code



Giveaways and flyers are only allowed if they are individually wrapped and sanitized

## CONTRACTORS GUIDELINES



Stand building companies and other contractors have to adhere to all the rules and regulations stipulated above and brief the onsite teams accordingly



Strictly no overtime construction hours due to extra cleaning measurements



Manpower should also adhere to the '1 person per 4 sqm' rule. Contractors will need to schedule their workforce to ensure that these numbers are not exceeded
