FOR VISITORS, EXHIBITORS & CONTRACTORS



Access to ADNEC is only for fully vaccinated persons



Before entering the venue during the show period (23, 24 & 25 November) you must be able to show a negative PCR test of maximum 96 hours old.



Sneeze/cough in the armpit



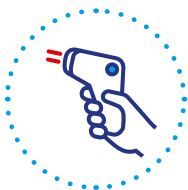
Avoid handshaking



Wear a mask covering nose and mouth



Wash/sanitize hands regularly



Temperature measurement at all the entrance points of ADNEC



Follow floor indications: one-way and two-way aisles indicated by floor marks

EXHIBITOR GUIDELINES



Brochures and flyers are recommended to be provided digitally or via QR code



Giveaways and flyers are only allowed if they are individually wrapped and sanitized



All exhibitors are advised to have hand sanitizing gel on their booth available during the whole show period.

CONTRACTORS GUIDELINES



Strictly no overtime construction hours due to extra cleaning measurements



Before entering the venue during construction and dismantling (21,22 & 26 November) you must be able to show a negative PCR test of maximum 7 days old.



Stand building companies and other contractors have to adhere to all the rules and regulations stipulated above and brief the onsite teams accordingly
